Technical Equipment

Sound

To play your music, simply connect to the receiver (large device on the shelf) via Bluetooth. The **remote control** should be found on top of the device.

1. Switch on the receiver by pressing "Bluetooth" on the remote control.
 - a. If you have been connected before, your device will connect automatically.
2. Press the Bluetooth button for at least 3 seconds until "Pairing" appears on the screen. You may also need to press "PC" on the remote control.
3. Connect to **"Onkyo TX-SR383D 4EE6FC"**

Lights

The **switch** next to the door can be removed. This allows you to set four different lighting scenes at the touch of a button and dim the light using the rotary knob.

You can also create your own lighting scenes or control all lamps individually. To do this, use the **tablet**, which should be located on the receiver.

1. Activate the tablet using the small button on the side.
2. Swipe up to access the home screen.
3. Open the **"Hue"** app.
4. Now select the **"Tavern"** room.
5. Here you can select existing light scenes, edit them or create completely new ones (option on the far right).

It is also possible to assign your own lighting scenes to the switch, which is useful during the session. To do this, go to Settings -> Accessories in the app.

Fireplace: The remote control should be placed directly on the fireplace. Switch it on using the power switch at the top left and then press the heating switch directly below it twice to switch off the heating function.

7. Switch on the receiver by pressing "Bluetooth" on the remote control.
8. The device will show "Please wait..." for approx. 30 seconds.
9. Then press "Bluetooth" on the remote control again until "Pairing" is displayed.
10. Connect to "**Denon AVR-X1700H**"
11. **Please note:** You may need to press "Musik" at the bottom of the remote control to get surround sound.

Infrastructure



Storage rooms

Groups that play at KuL frequently can use a storage space (please label your own compartment). The storage room is accessible via the stairwell (next door) and the key is in the key box in the entrance area. All unlabelled items such as projectors, fans, fog machines, cables, etc. may be used.

Printer: The printer (Canon LBP633C) in the storage room should be accessible via Wi-Fi. Alternatively, it can be used with the USB cable.

Kitchen

Snacks: Are free of charge. You are also welcome to leave your own snacks here (nothing that spoils quickly).

Drinks: Are available for purchase in the refrigerator (CHF 4). There are often free drinks available as well; please refer to the list on the refrigerator. You may also use the refrigerator during your session. The coffee machine is also subject to a charge (CHF 1).

Crockery: Everything in the kitchen is free to use. **Please do the dishes afterwards.** A few glasses can be cleaned directly in the toilet's sink, but it is best to take large amounts of crockery down to the cellar, where there is a large sink.

Rubbish: The cupboard marked "Recycling" is for glass, PET, cardboard and aluminium. Return all glass bottles from the fridge to the crates in the bar, except for beer bottles, which go in the glass recycling bin.

Miscellaneous

There are dice, trays, pens, etc. in all rooms. Minis can also be found everywhere, especially in the tavern. They can all be used.

Checklist before leaving

Please leave the room as you found it, or even cleaner and tidier!

- Close windows
- Turn off lights, music and fireplace
- Plug in tablet
- Put dice, cards, screens, etc. back in their place
- Turn off heating (to 1.5 in winter)

And most importantly:

- Lock the entrance door (and storage room)
- Put the key back in the box
